Staying Safe during a Flood

Do not walk swim or drive through flood waters. TURN AROUND DON'T DROWN	Stay off bridges over fast moving waters .	Evacuate if told to do so
Listen to Weather radio or Local alerting systems for emergency updates	Get to a high ground; DO NOT CLIMB INTO A CLOSED ATTIC	Be aware of risk of electrocution. Dont touch electrical equipment if it is wet or you are standing in water.
When cleaning up your home, wear gloves and boots. Snakes and animals may be in your home.	Always listen to authorities for instructions!	Return home only when authorities say it is safe

Flood Preparation Tips

- Prepare **NOW** not **LATER**. Sign up for community warning systems and have a clear evacuation plan ready.
- Practice evacuation routes.
- Purchase or renew flood insurance policy.
- Keep important documents in waterproof containers.
- Have important medication, phone chargers, extra batteries, pet supplies, and plenty of water and non-perishable foods in a emergency disaster kit.
